Temple Talk

Saturday, September 30, 2023 – 6:00 PM Sunday, October 1, 2023 – 8:00 AM and 10:30 AM

Good Evening/Morning.

The Autumn season is upon us. The signs of the harvest are all around. The weather has grown cooler. The corn fields, once green, are now fields of gold. Pumpkin patches are saturated with colors of Fall. Apple trees are abundant with fruit, ready for picking. It is the time of year when we gather, account, and store up for the season ahead. A time to reflect on the work that we have done. A time to thank God for the blessings we have received, and to look forward with joyful anticipation to that which is yet to come.

Here at Grace Lutheran Church, we have an almost 150-year legacy of being at work in the community. Employees and volunteers have spent countless hours serving through many of our ministries. Thanks be to God for those, of all ages, that serve as members of our various music ministries. Thanks be to God for the hands that prepare meals on Wednesday night and for other programs throughout the week. For the teachers in our English Language Learner program, for our teachers offering music lessons, teaching Sunday School, leading Confirmation Class, Vacation Bible School, Dramability, and our Youth Group. Thanks be to God for those that lead our books clubs, our prayer groups, and our Friday morning men's gathering. Thanks be to God for those serving on committees that upkeep this historic property, for those counting the money, paying the bills, and keeping the finances, for those that decorate, show hospitality, plan, prepare, and serve as worship volunteers. For those serving communion to our shut-ins and visiting with our visitors. Thanks be to God for those spending countless hours in support of Lancaster Housing and Neighborhood Development Services. May God continue to bless this ministry as we provide affordable housing within our community. Thanks be to God for those I have missed on this list. Thank you for all that you are doing.

We give thanks to God for those groups using our Education Building to provide services to our community. For the Day Care Center, Narcotics Anonymous, and all other groups. For the residents of our L-HANDS properties. May God bless and keep them this day and every day.

With a 150-year legacy of work in our community also comes a 150-year legacy of giving. Year-to-date, Grace Lutheran Church has realized an income of \$673,409. This represents gifts to our General Fund, Capital Campaign, and Investment Accounts. You have been generous in giving and we have been good stewards of these gifts, however, as we look ahead, we can all recognize that expenses are going to continue to rise. Our goal this season is to increase giving to our General Fund. This is where your generosity is needed once again. With the goal of continuing all the programs listed that each of you so generously support with your time and resources, I am asking you to consider your level of generosity.

As in the past, our goal this Fall is to increase our giving from 100% of our congregation by 1%. For those that are already giving, we ask you to prayerfully consider adding at least a 1% increase to your existing giving. For those who are not yet giving, we ask for you to prayerfully consider beginning the habit of tithing. Scriptures tell us that we are to present one tenth of what we receive as a tithe to God. I acknowledge for some, giving up 10% of your income is not much of a concern. For others, it is of great concern. If you find yourself among the latter, then start by giving what you can. It does not matter if you are calculating your gifts on your gross income or net income. What matters is that you choose to give. If you can give 5% of your income, then give 5%. If you can give 1% of your income, then give 1%. Our goal is for each person that calls themselves a member of Grace Lutheran Church to give something. 100% participation increasing our current giving by at least 1%.

In the days ahead, you will be hearing from our Stewardship Committee. Between now and then, I ask you to meditate and pray, asking the Holy Spirit to guide you in your generosity.

Malachai 3:10 tells us "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the LORD Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it."

Generosity generates joy. God loves a joyful giver and so do we. Is this a challenge you are willing to accept?

In this harvest season, let each of us join in gathering, accounting, and storing up for the season ahead. Let us reflect on the work that we have done. Let us thank God for the blessings we have received. Let the Holy Spirit increase our generosity as we look forward with joyful anticipation to that which is yet to come.

May grace, mercy, generosity, and peace be upon you.
